- IPRA holding data on your fuel samples.
- Display the IPRA QA signage in your forecourt.
- Have your name displayed in the QA section of the IPRA website.
- Hold an adequate insurance policy including cover for damage to vehicles.
- QA Membership requires you to be a paid up member of IPRA.
- If membership lapses you must remove all QA Logo from your site.

By signing up to the IPRA Quality Assurance Scheme you agree that should you be found to have adulterated/fuel of non-merchantable quality that IPRA can remove your company from the QA site and advise consumers through the media that your company no longer is a participant on the scheme. You further agree to remove any QA signage from your site and stop all use of any QA signage.

Disclaimer; IPRA is the promoter of this voluntary QA scheme only. IPRA accepts no responsibility for any loss or liability to any customer who purchases fuel from an IPRA member. Any dispute over fuel quality is between the retailer and the customer.
